International Problem-based Learning Experience in Veterinary Medicine (IPLEX Vet Med)

(May 6<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup> and July 25<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup> 2022)

An interactive blended learning of 7 full days (4 half days on line and 5 full days face to face) spread over 2 weeks,

based on discussion of case studies specifically tailored for 3 areas of the Veterinary Medicine Curriculum

(Companion Animals Medicine, Farm Animals Medicine, Wildlife Eco-pathology and Public Health), supervised by

professors from three European Universities: University of Padova (Italy), Universidade do Porto (Portugal),

Estonian University of Life Sciences (Tartu, Estonia). The course will be held by University of Padova as Blended

Intensive Programme (BIP).

Selected students (8 students from each University) will be divided into 3 groups (8 students each, belonging to

the 3 universities) which will work independently to discuss and solve 1 case study for each thematic area (same

cases for all the groups), supported by a facilitator and interacting with professors from the three Universities.

The teaching activity will be based on the **Problem Based Learning (PBL) methodology**.
